

BEDFORD POLICE PENSION FUND BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees of the Bedford Police Pension Fund then met for a public meeting at the Bedford Police Department's Training Room on Thursday, February 5, 2026 at 1:30 pm.

The following members were present: Mayor Craig, Chief Moore, Secretary Turpen and Trustees DeWees, Bridges, Wade, and Herr. Notification was made but no members of the media or public were present. The meeting was livestreamed.

Mayor Craig called the meeting to order.

Motion to accept minutes of last meeting, September 25, 2025 as presented. Motion to accept by Chief Moore, seconded by Trustee Bridges. Motion passed unanimously.

Nominations opened to fill two 3-year Trustee terms previously held by Trustees Turpen and Bridges; and for the 2026 Pension Secretary.

Trustee DeWees nominated Turpen for Trustee position, seconded by Trustee Bridges.
Motion to close nominations by Trustee DeWess, second by Trustee Bridges. Motion passed unanimously.
Trustee Turpen passed unanimously.

Trustee Herr nominated Bridges for Trustee position, seconded by Trustee Wade.
Motion to close nominations by Trustee DeWess, second by Chief Moore. Motion passed unanimously.
Trustee Bridges passed unanimously.

Chief Moore nominated Turpen for 2026 Secretary, seconded by Trustee Bridges.
There being no further nominations, nominations were closed.
Secretary Turpen passed unanimously.

There being no further business, motion by Trustee Herr to adjourn, seconded by Trustee DeWees.
Motion passed unanimously and meeting was closed.
