New Business:

1. Request Approval For Advertising Bids For Street Department New Office And Shop Building-David Flinn-Street Commissioner

- David Flinn requested the Board approve the advertising bid requests for the new street department.
- The office section is 50x80 at 4,000 sq ft, the garage is 80x90 at 7,200 sq ft.
- ❖ Judy Carlisle made the motion to approve the request to advertise for bids for the new street department building,
- ❖ Charlene Hall seconded the motion.

2. Request Approval To List Sale Price For Retired Rescue Truck \$199,000.-Chief Luke Pinnick

- Chief Pinnick requested approval to list the fire department's retired rescue truck for the price of \$199,000 through Garage Technologies, Inc.
- Garage Technologies is an on-line marketplace for fire trucks.
- ❖ Charlene Hall made the motion to approve the request to list the retired rescue truck on Garage Technologies for \$199,000.

- Mayor Craig stated that Brandon Woodward worked on obtaining quotes for new chairs for the new meeting room.
- Mayor Craig requested the Board approve the lowest quote from Bedford Office Supply in the amount of \$14,127.

**4. Request Acceptance Of Quotes For Painting Catwalk At City Hall-Brandon
Woodward-Fleet & Facilities Director**

- J & J Painting LLC-\$3,500.
- Miller Precision Painting-No Response
- Superior Painting Service, LLC-No Response
- Mayor Craig stated that Brandon Woodward requested three quotes to paint the catwalk at city hall a red color. It is currently white and it did match city hall when it was white. It connects city hall to the building next door on the second floor.
- J & J Painting LLC was the only contractor to respond with a quote.

- ❖ Charlene Hall made the motion to approve the quote from J & J Painting LLC in the amount of \$3,500.
- ❖ Judy Carlisle seconded the motion.

**5. Request Acceptance Of Quotes For Pressure Washing Front of Meeting Hall And
TASC Building-Brandon Woodward-Fleet & Facilities Director**

- Hoosier Power Wash-No Response
- Mayor Craig stated that Brandon Woodward requested three quotes for pressure washing the meeting hall and the TASC building from three vendors. New signage will be going up on the meeting hall building and the buildings need cleaned.

- Mayor Craig requested the Board accept the only quote received from Ace Powerwashing LLC for \$2,400.
- ❖ Judy Carlisle made the motion to approve the quote from Ace Powerwashing LLC in the amount of \$2,400.

6. Request Approval Of Purchase Agreement For Property Located At The Corner Of John Williams Blvd. And X Street-Mayor Sam Craig

- City Attorney Greg Pittman stated that RDC approved a purchase agreement to purchase the property at John Williams and X Street. Appraisals were received from two appraisal firms. RDC will purchase the property, but it will be transferred to The City of Bedford at some point. The property will be the location of the proposed north end fire station.
- ❖ Charlene Hall made the motion to approve the purchase agreement in the amount of \$379,000 .
- ❖ Judy Carlisle seconded the motion.
- ❖ *All votes were in favor, No one opposed, Approved.*

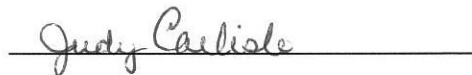
