New Business:

1. Request

- Request Approval Of Payment To Flynn & Sons Excavating For Paving Contract-\$444,337.30-David Flinn-Street Commissioner.
- Mr. Flinn stated that the paving is completed for this season. He requested payment to Flynn & Sons for the completion of the paving.
- ❖ Charlene Hall made the motion to approve the payment to Flynn & Sons for paving,
- ❖ Mayor Craig seconded the motion.
- ❖ *All votes were in favor, No one opposed, Approved.*

2. Request Approval of Payment to Flynn & Sons Excavating For Waterline Relocation On State Road 58-\$227,221.50-Misty Adams-Utilities Director

- Ms. Adams stated that the contract for the relocation of the water line on State Road 58 has been completed. INDOT required the line to be relocated due to a culvert relocation project.

- She requested payment to Flynn & Sons for the completion of the water line contract.
- ❖ Mayor Craig made the motion to approve the payment to Flinn & Sons for the water line relocation in the amount of \$227,221.50.
- ❖ Charlene Hall seconded the motion.
- ❖ *All votes were in favor, No one opposed, Approved.*

3. Request Approval And Appointment Of Special Officer-Chief Terry Moore

- Chief Moore stated pursuant to the MOU approved at the May 19, 2026 BOW meeting, North Lawrence Community Schools has hired Brian Turpen to serve as the School Resource Officer at Bedford Middle School.
- In accordance with that agreement, he requested the Board's approval to appoint Brian Turpen as a Special Officer for the City of Bedford. This appointment will allow him to fulfill his duties as a School Resource Officer and exercise the necessary law enforcement authority while serving on the school property.
- Charlene Hall asked if there was a term on the appointment. Chief Moore stated that the MOU agreement state that it ends June 30 each year but will continue with no changes.
- ❖ Charlene Hall made the motion to appoint Brian Turpen as Special Office for the City of Bedford at Bedford Middle School.
- ❖ Mayor Craig seconded the motion.
- ❖ *All votes were in favor, No one opposed, Approved.*

4. Request Approval of Contract And Payment To Wisley Pyrotechnics For July 4th Fireworks-Brandon Woodward-Fleet & Facilities Director

- Brandon Woodward requested the board approve the contract with Wisley Pyrotechnics for the July 4th fireworks display. The contract states \$24,000 not to exceed \$25,000.
- Mayor Craig added that there were additional donations received and he spoke with Mr. Wisley prior to the meeting and would like the contract to be \$25,000.
- ❖ Mayor Craig made the motion to approve the contract with Wisley Pyrotechnics for \$25,000 allow for payment of the contract after the completion of the fireworks display.
- ❖ Charlene Hall seconded the motion.
- ❖ *All votes were in favor, No one opposed, Approved.*

- Mayor Craig asks Chief Moore for a clarification on the Special Office at Bedford Middle School and if he authority would continue on other school properties.
- Chief Moore stated that the MOU with NLCS states NLCS properties, it is his understanding that it would be all of NLCS properties.
